FORT WORTH BOND APPROVAL PROPELS HERITAGE PARK PROJECT

On May 7, 2022, Fort Worth voters approved the citywide bond propositions by wide margins. Proposition B, the parks proposition, included two significant line items for Downtown Fort Worth. The Fort Worth Water Gardens will receive much-needed infrastructure upgrades, and \$13.5M will be dedicated to Heritage Park, Heritage Park Plaza, and Paddock Park on the north side of the Tarrant County Courthouse.

The parks proposition approval adds significant fuel to the Heritage Park effort. The next steps for the revitalization project are to approve the final designs, generate reliable construction cost estimates, and reach our fundraising goals.
