Dear Business Community Partners,

The City of Fort Worth is implementing a four year program to resurface streets in the downtown area. For a block by block breakdown of planned construction, please see the attached project schedule by year of the planned start of construction. Road construction will include repaying the asphalt roadway from curb-to-curb, installation of Americans with Disabilities Act (A.D.A.) compliant curb ramps at intersections, and new pavement markings.

Construction for the roadway segments listed as 2019 in the attachment are scheduled to begin in December 2018. The city will host a pre-construction meeting with the contractor and business owners on November 27, 2018 at the Fort Worth Central Library at 2 p.m. and 6 p.m. to ensure stakeholders are aware of the upcoming construction schedule and pertinent construction contacts. Construction contractors will minimize construction impacts by keeping a clean work site, following parking regulations, and maintaining safety signage. In general, construction crews will be working from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Permission to work on weekends may be granted, if necessary.
